EUSA Safeguarding and Incident Policy

With the current Policy, EUSA clarifies the **expectations**, and **consequences**, regarding the **behavior of different stakeholders at EUSA's events** to allow the creation of a safe and enjoyable environment.

All participants (EUSA, Guests, Referees, Athletes, Officials) are under the scope of application of the Safeguarding and Incident Policy. EUSA enforces a zero-tolerance policy.

Globally the document:

- Provides a scope by defining **persons covered and time framework**;
- Defines **proper** and **transgressive behaviour**;
- Establishes a procedure to for **reporting** and **addressing** incidents;
- Defines a list of possible **sanctions** to be applied by the SCAC.

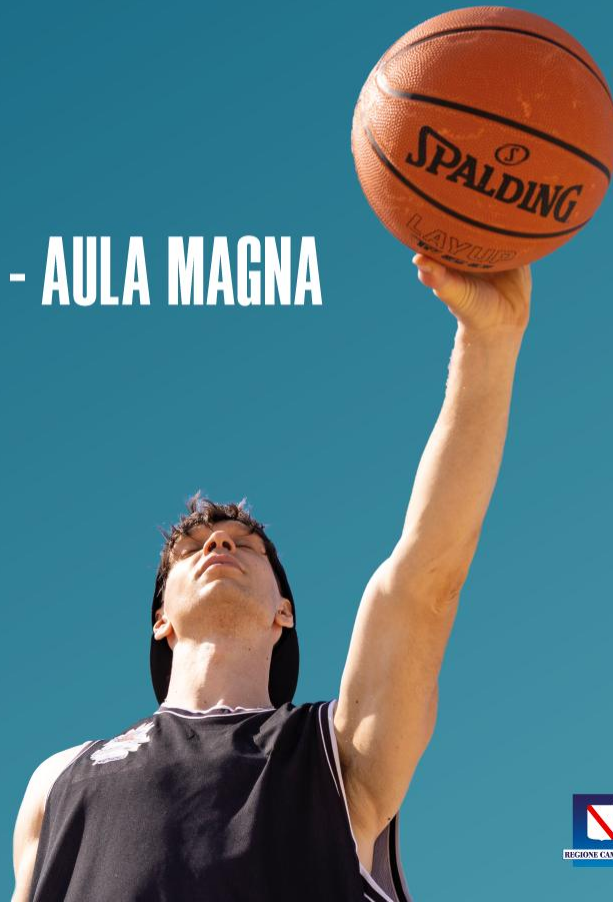

Competition Format - Men

Group Stage:

- The twenty four (24) participating teams will be divided into four (4) groups (A, B, C, D) of six (6) teams each. Each team will play all the other teams in its own group (total 5 games for each team).

Knock-out phase:

- The teams placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each group will qualify for the last 16, Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals (places 1st – 16th).
- The teams placed 5th and 6th in each group will automatically be rank 17th till 24th place.
- From the last 16 games, the knock out phase start. The winners from the last 16 continue to the quarter finals, winners quarter finals continue to semi-finals, losers semi final will play for the 3rd place and the winners will play for the first place.

Competition Format - Women

Group Stage:

- The twenty (20) participating teams will be divided into four (4) groups (A, B, C, D) of five (5) teams each. Each team will play all the other teams in its own group (total 4 games for each team).

Knock-out phase:

- The teams placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each group will qualify for the last 16, Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals (places 1st – 16th).
- The teams placed 5th in each group will automatically be rank 17th till 20th place.
- From the last 16 games, the knock out phase start. The winners from the last 16 continue to the quarter finals, winners quarter finals continue to semi-finals, losers semi final will play for the 3rd place and the winners will play for the first place.

Ranking after all Group Matches

If teams that have reached the same stage of the competition are tied, the steps to break the tie shall be applied in the following order. Each step shall be calculated only once. If teams are still tied after one step, the next step shall be applied to break the tie between those teams still tied:

1. Most wins (or win ratio in case of unequal number of games in inter-pool comparison).
2. Head-to-head comparison (only taking win/loss into account and applies within a pool only).
3. Most points scored in average (without considering winning scores of forfeits), albeit considering never more than 21 points in each single game, irrespectively if score is above 21.

Example:

Team scores 22 points in game 1 and 18 points in game 2

- Total score is 39 point (not 40) and average score is 19.5 points (not 20).

This means teams shall not hunt for 22 points. Makes no more sense as we anyway will only count 21 points in standing calculations. Teams shall finish the games as soon as possible.

If teams are still tied after those three steps, the one(s) with the highest seeding win(s) the tie-breaker. If this is still not possible, the draw will define the ranking.

Competition & Trainings

MATCH COUNTDOWN

- 5 minutes before the start of match all the players go to playing court
- Warm up sessions 2 minute on court
- If a team is late more then 3 minutes it will be technical loss (DSQ from EUC)
- Before each game, every player must put accreditation on the officials table

TRAINING SESSIONS & WARM UP

- Training schedule are set only for the 01th of August, there will be no training sessions during the tournament.
- Warm up possible before the game on court no.4 and 5 indoor.

UNIFORMS:

- All teams have to bring 2 (two) different sets of uniforms, main colour light and the other dark.
- During the entire duration of the EUC competition each player must wear the same number.
- First team in the game schedule plays in light uniform, the second team plays in dark uniform.

SHOOT OUT CONTEST

Qualification: 02th OF AUGUST AT 07.30pm PM WOMEN AND 03th OF AUGUST AT 07.30pm MEN

- Max. 1 player per team
- 2 racks of 5 balls, each one worth 1 point
- Need to shoot with in 30 seconds
- Last ball is 2 point worth
- Tiebreaker (same points and time): tied players shoot again
- **Best 5 women and 5 men qualify for the final**

FINAL SHOOT OUT CONTEST

FINAL: 05th OF AUGUST AT 08.30pm

- 3 racks of 5 balls, each one worth 1 point
- The balls on the logo are 3 points worth
- Need to shoot with in 60 seconds
- Tiebreaker (same points and time): Tied players shoot again

DUNK CONTEST

Qualification: 04th OF AUGUST AT 07.30pm

- Max. 1 player per team
- Each player has 30 seconds to dunk, the first good dunk counts.
- **Best 5 players qualify for the Final**

THE FINAL WILL BE ON THE 05th OF AUGUST AT 07.15PM ON COURT #1

FINAL DUNK CONTEST

FINAL: 05th OF AUGUST AT 07.15pm

- Five contestants, who each dunk twice in the first round
- Two contestants with the highest combined scores from the first round will advance to the second round
- Two contestants, who each dunk twice in the second round
- The contestant with the highest combined score in the second round is the winner
- Dunks are evaluated by five judges and can earn up to 50 points

Participation in the Competition

All participating team (after being confirmed by the draw) **shall participate in all scheduled matches**.

If the team or competitor **misses any of the scheduled matches** (without justified reason announced in advance), **they will be disqualified** from the event and a fine of maximum 2000 EUR will be imposed by the EUSA. That University (represented by the participating team or competitor) will not have the right to participate in EUSA events until the fine has been received by the EUSA.

In addition, the SCAC will submit a report to the EUSA EC who may, at their discretion, ban that University from all EUSA events for a period of minimum 1 (one) year. In such circumstances, a report will be submitted to the rector of that University and to the NUSA setting out the reasons for the ban.





- Protest on referees decision are not permitted
- (IT IS IMPORTANT THAT CAPTAIN OF THE TEAM SIGNS THE SCORESHEET IMMEDIATELY AFTER END OF THE GAME ON WHICH THEY WANT TO PUT A COMPLAINT).**
- Each protest shall be accompanied by a deposit of two hundred (200) EUR.

Determination of the seeding for the draw

The recent National Champion for each NUSA is considered within the EUSA Ranking List. If there is more than one (1) team from the same NUSA, all remaining teams are all together in the last pool for the draw (no difference between them).

The NUSA National Champion is seeded in accordance with the EUSA Ranking List

The Draw

The university team of the hosting city or in their absence the hosting country's highest ranked team is already drawn into the group / place A1.

The remaining teams will be drawn into groups. The draw firstly will be done for all first positions in each groups, then the second positions, third etc. for women, and for men – it is bottom up.

Teams from the same country shall, whenever possible, be placed in different groups.
